

Monochromatic: a group of colors that are tints and shades of a single color.


Select a color and mix a tint and shade of that color to show an example of monochromatic colors:




Tint: is the mixture of a color with white, which increases lightness

Shade: is the mixture of a color with black, which reduces lightness.


Complementary Colors: are colors directly opposite each other on the color wheel.
